Additional Details of Offense, Progress of Investigation, etc.

July 14, 1954 - Richard and Betty Knitter of 785 Kenilworth, Sheffield Lake, Ohio came in to report that on the early morning of July 4th they were returning to their home from Loews State theatre in Cleveland they saw man in vicinity of cemetery.

They state that upon leaving the movie at 2:30 A.M. they walked to their car and drove out to Bearden's Drive In where they stopped for a sandwich. They estimate the time to be between 3:30 & 4:00 A.M. when they went past the cemetery and they noticed a man on the North side of Lake Road walking East toward Cleveland. This man was white, between 32-42 years of age, wearing dark blue trousers, light colored short sleeved shirt. Wide nose, bushy crew cut hair light auburn in color, bushy eyebrows, long sideburns.

At this time Lakewood Police Dept. contacted in regards to someone drawing sketch of this description.
