GUIDELINES FOR REVIEWING AN ARTICLE

1. General Evaluation:

- Paper is ready for publication with some minor corrections.
- Paper is acceptable for publication but need some major revisions.
- Paper is not recommended for publication.

2. Evaluation of the article:

- What does the researcher want to find out? To what degree does the researcher accomplish the investigation?
- Why is that important to investigate or understand?
- How are the researchers investigating this? Are their research methods appropriate and adequate to the task?
- How does this advance knowledge in the field? How well does the researcher place his/her findings within the context of ongoing scholarly inquiry about this topic?
- How clear are the focus and quality of writing?
- Are the conclusions clear, strong, and relevant?
- Are the implications and recommendations clear, strong, and relevant?
- Are the tables (if any) clear, readable, and appropriate?
- What are your recommendations and corrections?
