Stayed at sister's on July 2nd & also July 3rd. Left her home Sunday morning July 4th at about 8:30 A.M. I got to Public Square & remained there most of afternoon. Tried hitchhiking late afternoon but got no ride & started walking. Don't know where I stayed Sunday night. Walked until I was picked up by Avon Lake Police Dept.
