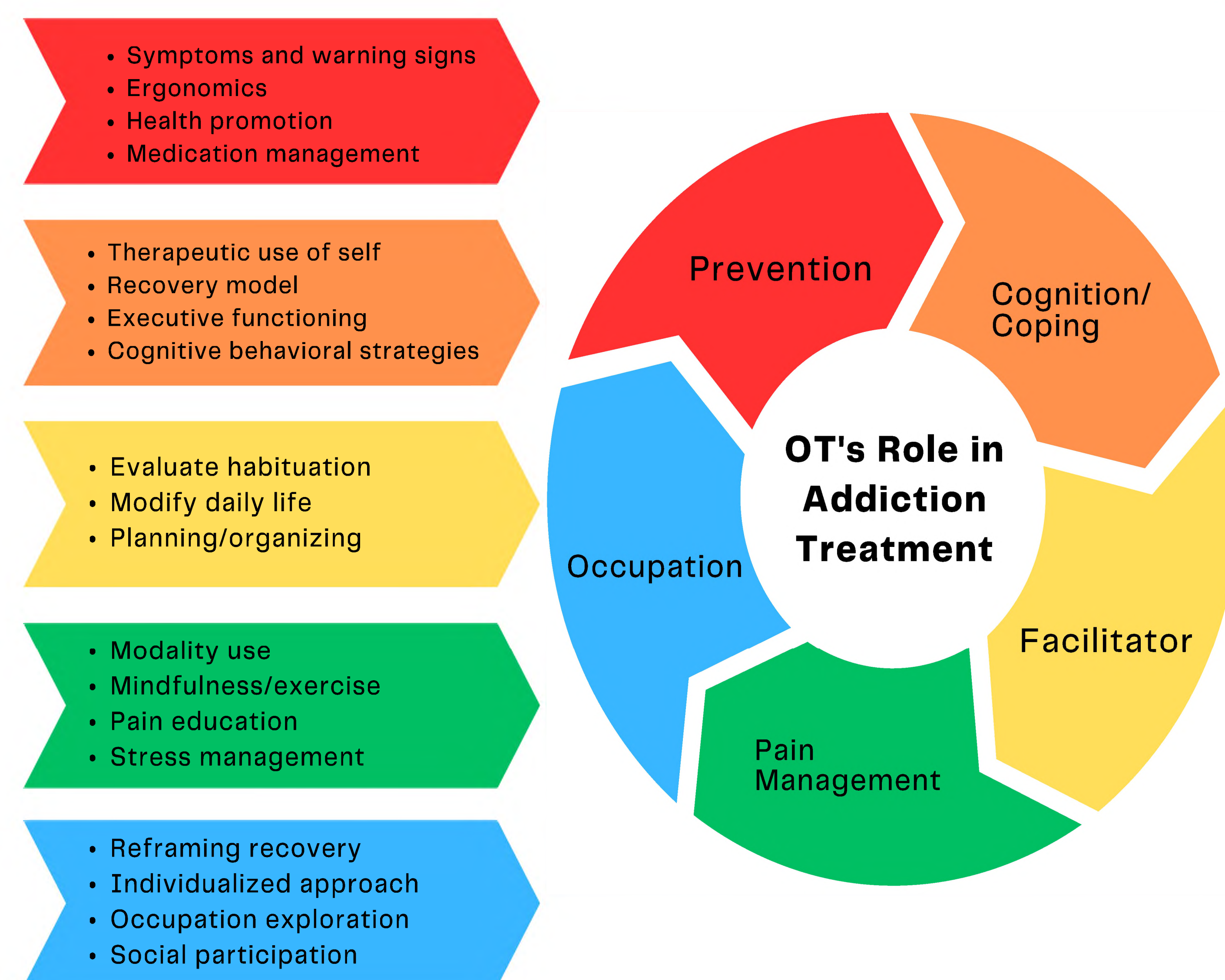
Community Safe Space for Individuals Impacted by the Opioid Epidemic

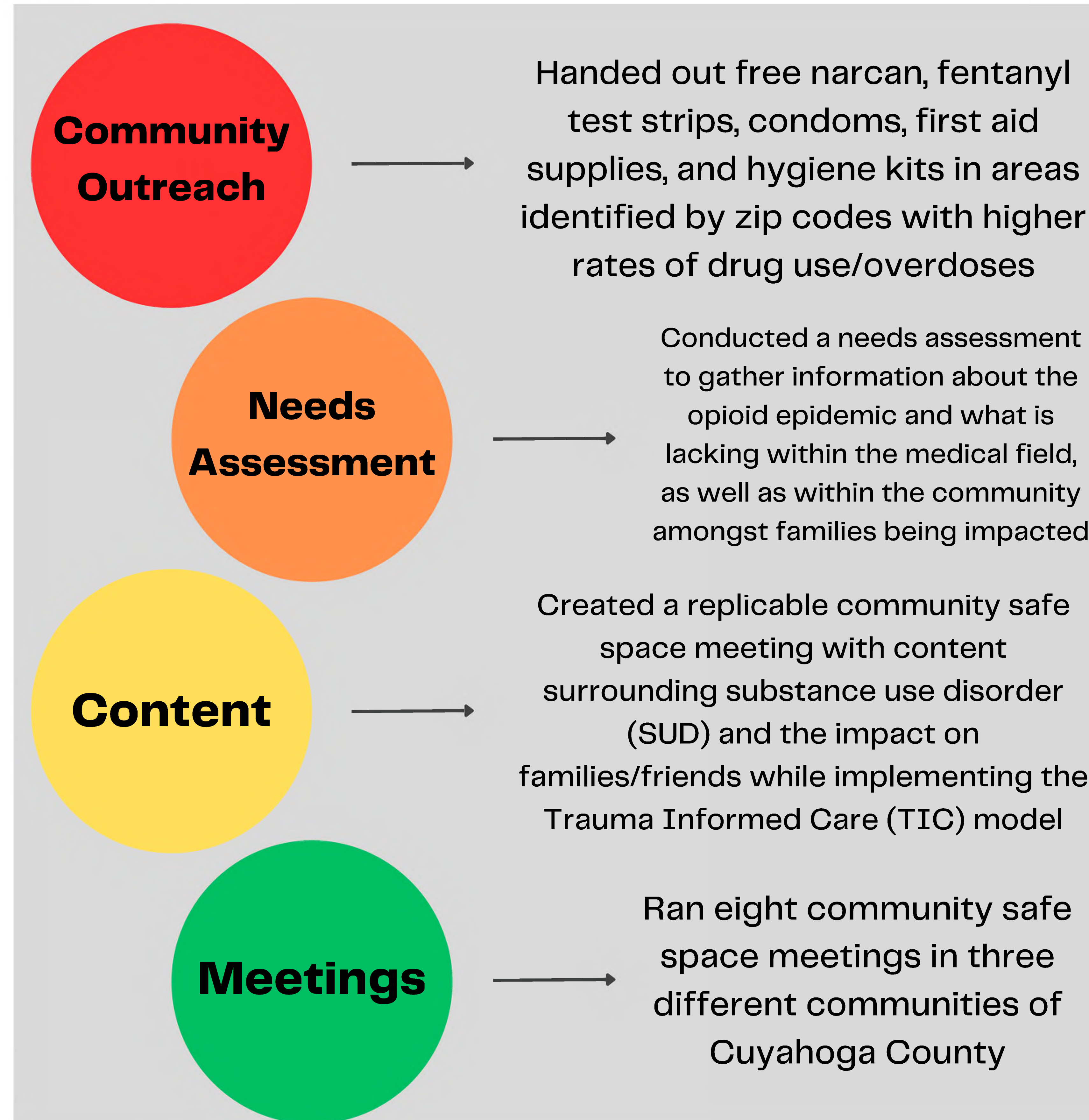


Biography

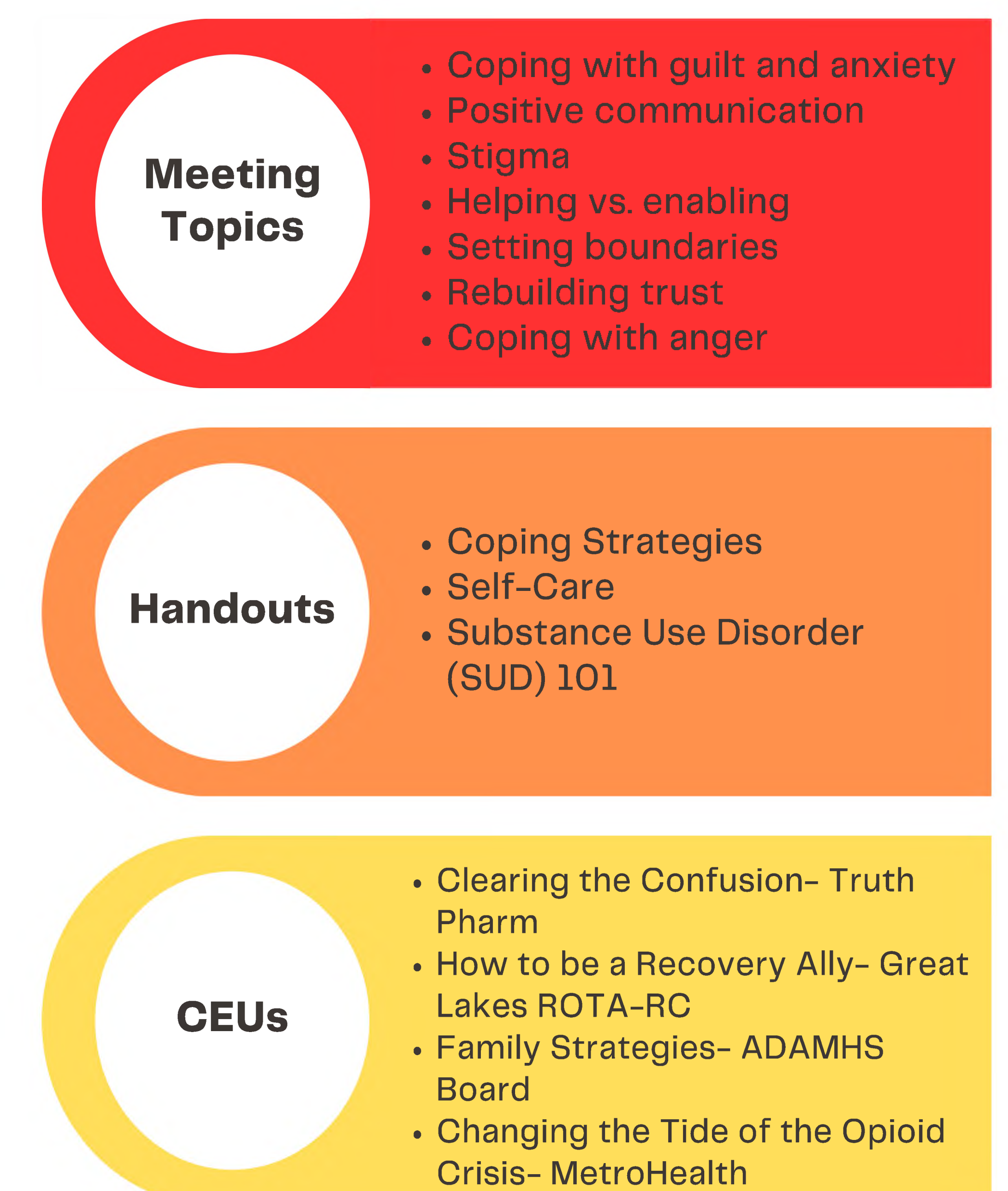
