I understand that I am not compelled to make this statement and that I have no control over how it may be used and that no promises are made to me because of it.

I am 23 yrs. old and I live at home with my parents Theros Hall and Vera Marie Hall. My grandmother lives in Huron at Box 171 Huron O. 17th Statts. She is sick and my parents about there Sat aft. I was on my way to join them, I ~~left~~ stayed out in the open last night because I had no key. This was in Rocky River. I left there about 6:15 A.M. I was picked up by a Rocky River Captain of police who took me west and dropped me off 3 mi further on. I was picked up by another policeman in Car #22, a black Chevrolet. I was picked up by a man going to work who took me approx 8 mi or more. I was then picked up by a Captain in Car 43. He took me about 3 mi west and then I walked. Car No 22 picked me up and took me to Sheffield Fire Sta. He called 43 back who brought me to Bay Village Police Sta.
