This date, at the request of Det. Sergt. Lockwood, made a long-distance telephone call to MRS. DONHA BAILEY, at Montebells, Los Angelus, California with reference to the Homicide of Marilyn Sheppard. Charges for this call will be paid by this Department. They amounted to \$4.50, and the call was made over Ms.1-1260, Ext. 303. DONHA BAILEY8s telephone # is Pacific 8-3813.

Interviewed Mrs Beiley with respect to a statement that she had made to me and Det. Schottke, in which she related that she had been a receptionsst at the Shappard Clinic at West 221st St., Fairview Park, Ohio and that during the course of her employment, she had intercepted a latter addressed to Dr. Sam Shappard from Miss SUE HAYED. Mrs Beiley had stated that she had read some of this latter and then had discovered that it was a personal latter for there were some personal remarks therein. She further had stated that she had been afraid that Dr. Sam would not like her opening this latter and that she had her hushand, Dr. Robert Beiley, intern at Bey View Hospital, inform Dr. Sam of her error. Mrs Beiley had stated that Dr. SAm had told her not to open any more lat are of that nature.

DONNA BAILRY stated that apparently, Dr. Sam had told Merilyn of her openin g this letter because she had invited Dr. Sem and Marilyn to her apartment of the 19th of April for a Birthday perty. Mrs Beiley further stated that some time during the course of that evening, Dr. Sem went to the Clinic downsteirs to ettend a meeting and that MARILYM SHEPPARD, in the presence of her husband (Donne Beiley's) told them that Sem was playing around and that Marilyn asked her sem to procure one of the letters that Dr. Sem was receiving from Sue Hayes. MARILIA further told her that SAM had hurt her all that he possibly could have and that she, Marilyn, was collocating evidence against him. merilyn stated that she had suffered enough and that now she was going to sit beek and watch Sem suffer and that she was going to drag his name through the mud and that she was going to ruin him professionally and financially and that letter, if Donna Beiley would give or get one for her, would help her. DONNA BAILEY stated that she told MARILYN that she could not do that as she was an employee and as such, wold not get a letter because she thought that it was unethical.

There were other conversation between them at this time that I do not recall her telling me at this time but the conversation was in the same vein.
