AFTER THE VERDICT, Dr. Stephen Sheppard and his wife, Betty, saddened at the finding of the seven men and five women jurors, hurry away from Criminal Courts Bldg. They remained long enough to hear Dr. Sam Sheppard sentenced to life in prison.



THEIR LONG VIGIL ENDED, Dr. Richard Sheppard and his wife, Dorothy, their eyes downcast and faces showing disappointment, left the courtroom after the jury ended its long deliberation over fate of Dr. Sam, youngest of the three osteopath brothers. Dr. Richard called the verdict an "unjust finding."
