This date while assigned with Det. Gareau further investigated the above report.

We learned the following from Folice Chief John Eston of Eay Village, Onio.

That Dr. Sam Shepherd had been seeing a nurse from Bayview Hospital and that he had been going out with her several times and in fact had given her several gifts, one of which was a wrist watch. This had have ened in the last few years and when Mrs. Shepperd found out about this there were several arguments in which Dr. Shepperd would fly into a rage.

The nurse then left the hospital and moved to Los Angeles, salif. Then about six months ago there was some type of convention in Los agales and both the Shappards had gone there. While Mrs. Shappard was in the hills Dr. Shappard was supposed to be seeing the nurse while he was in Los Angeles. When Mrs. Shappard found out about this there were several more arguments in which Dr. Shappard was supposed to fly into a rage.

The Chief also told us that on two different occasions when Dr. Sheppard would fly into these rages Mrs. Sheppard whale was in fear of her life.

The Chief stated that he did not want this information to be known that it came from him as the Mayor (Houk) of bay Village did not want this to get out or to be known.
