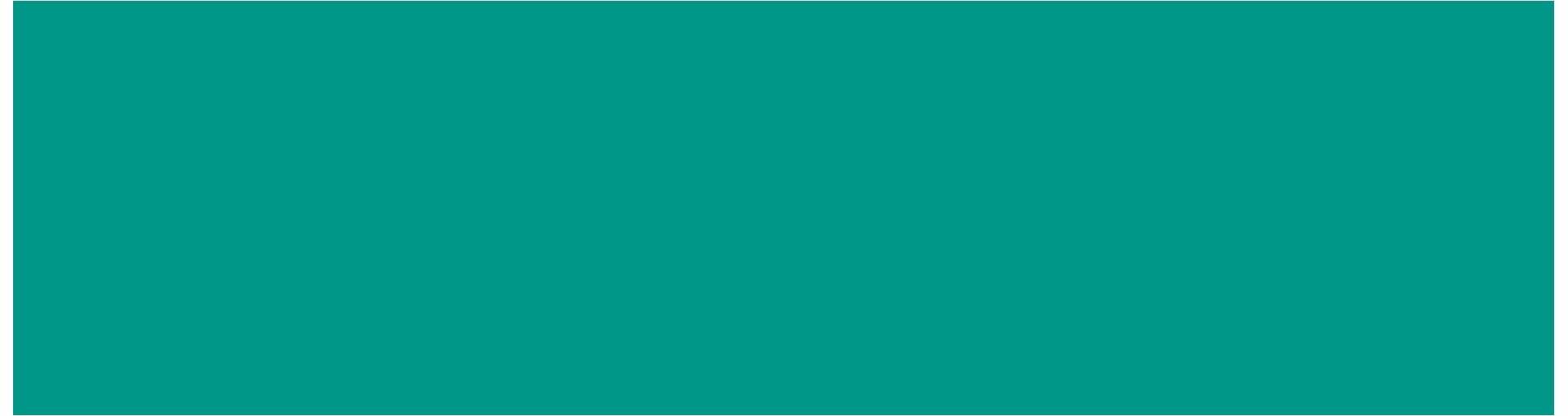

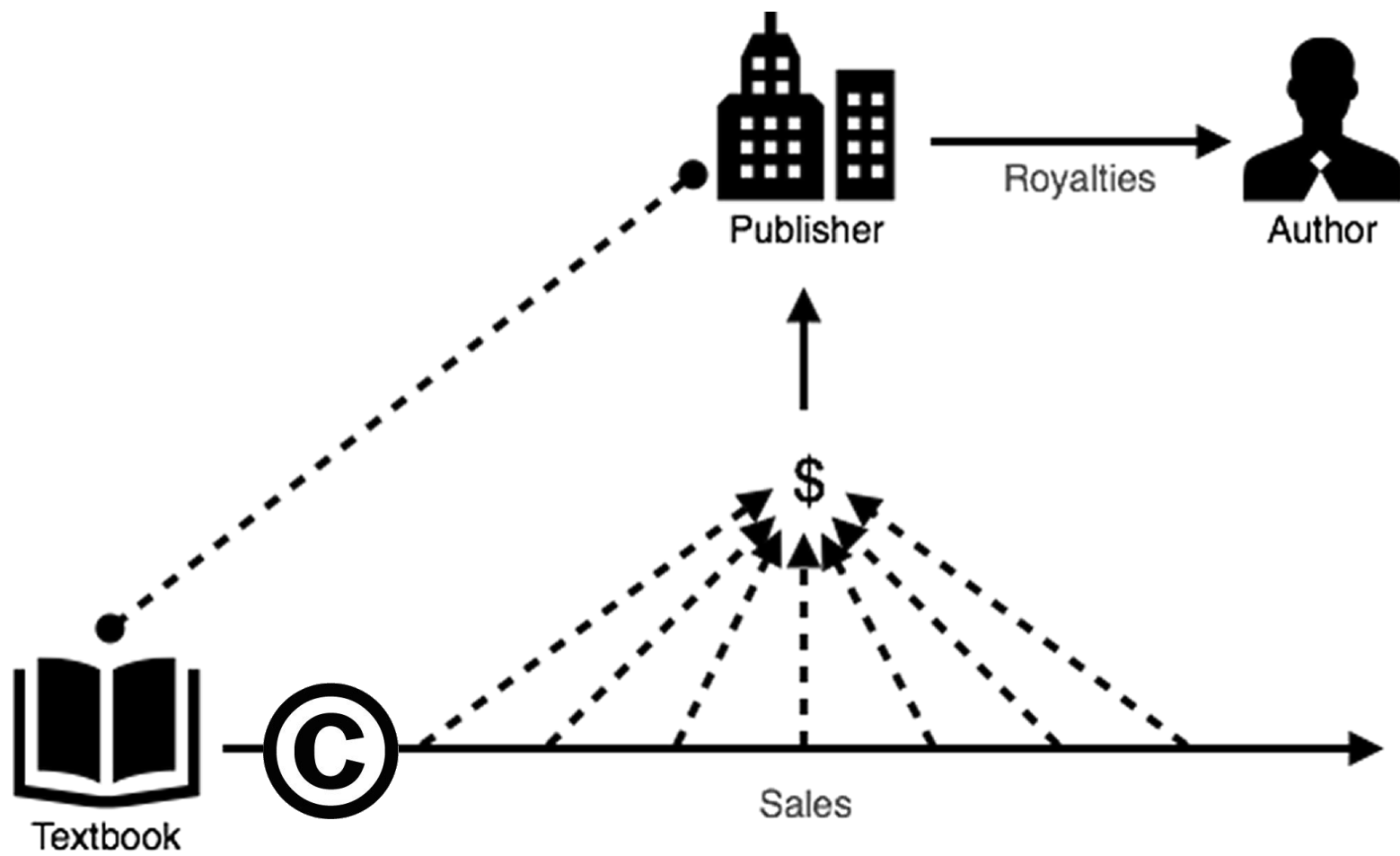


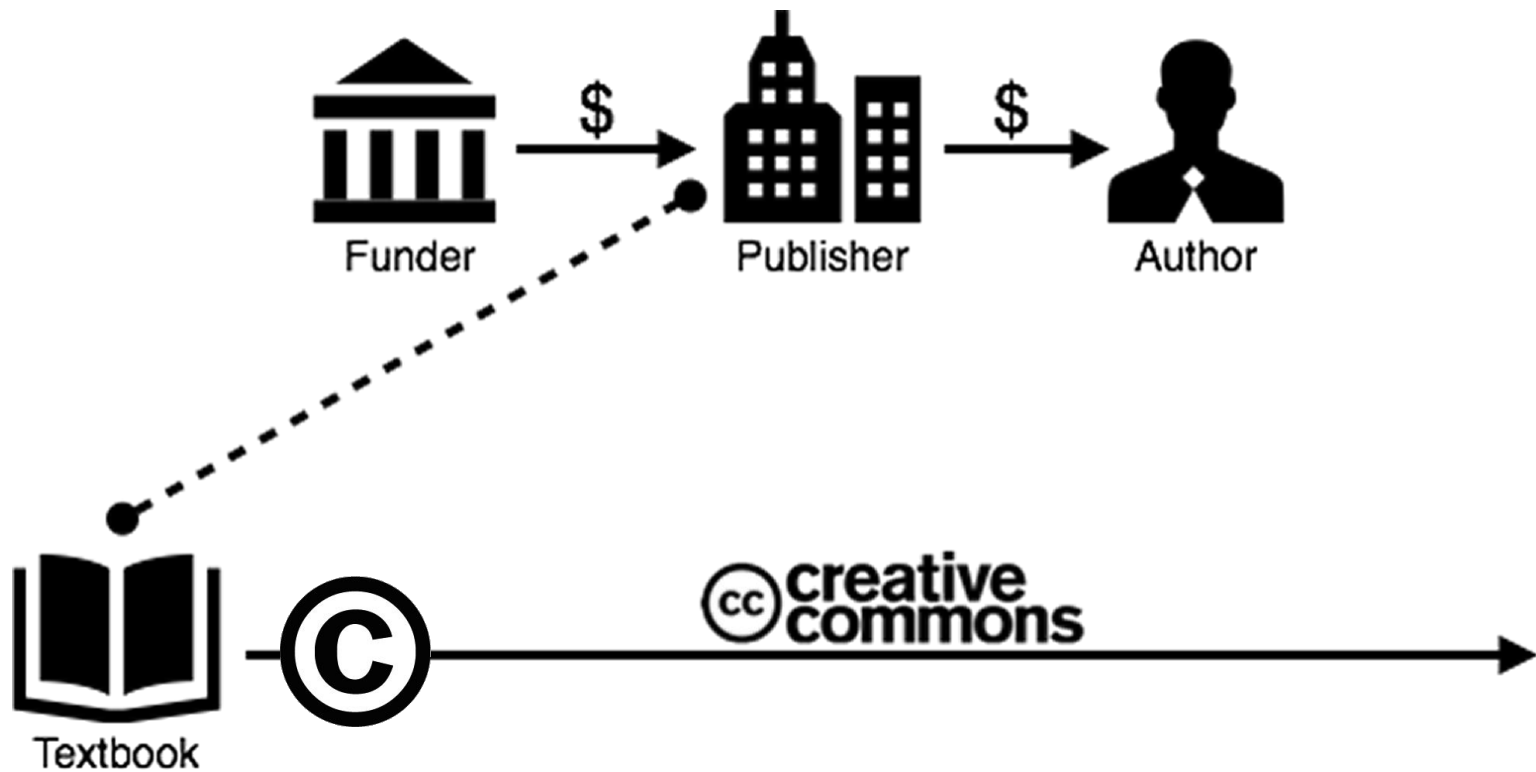

Where does the funding come from?

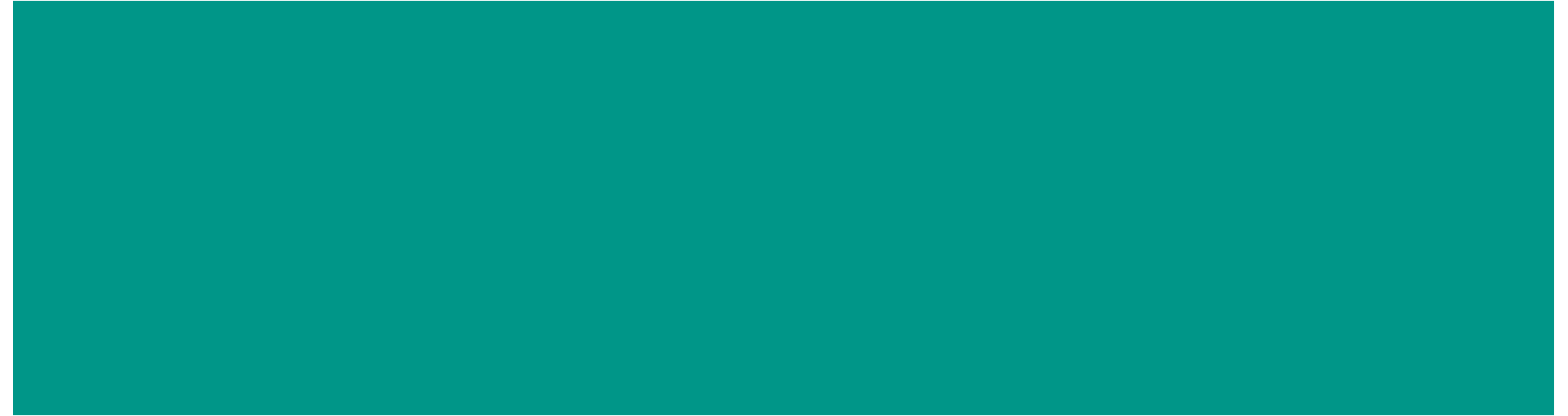
- Universities

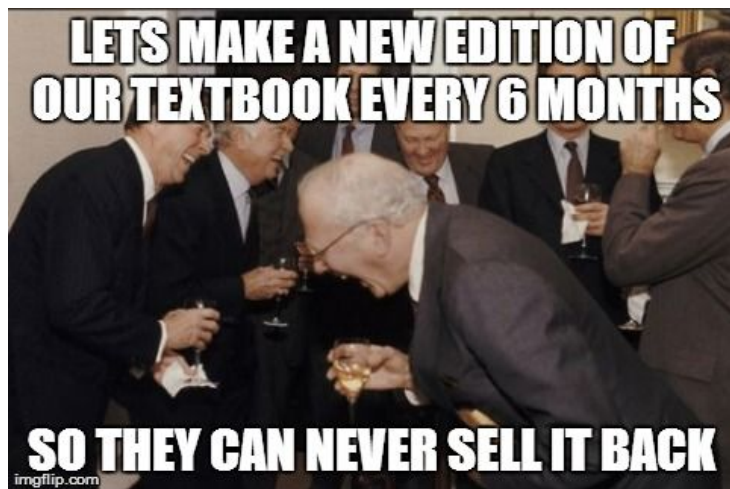

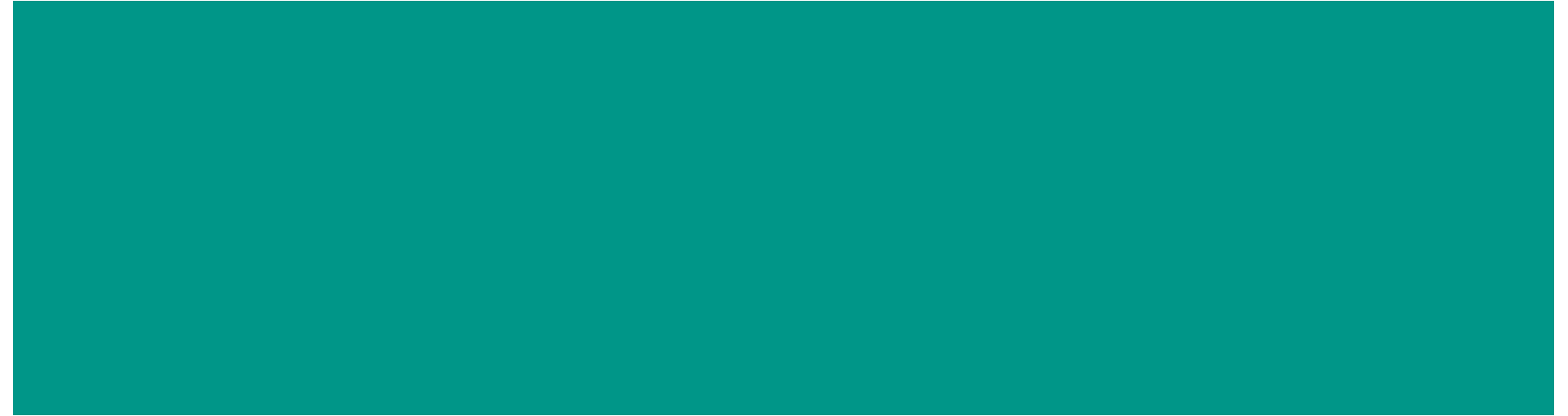
Coping with the Cost

 - Never purchase the textbook
 - Share the textbook with other students

- Download textbooks illegally from the internet

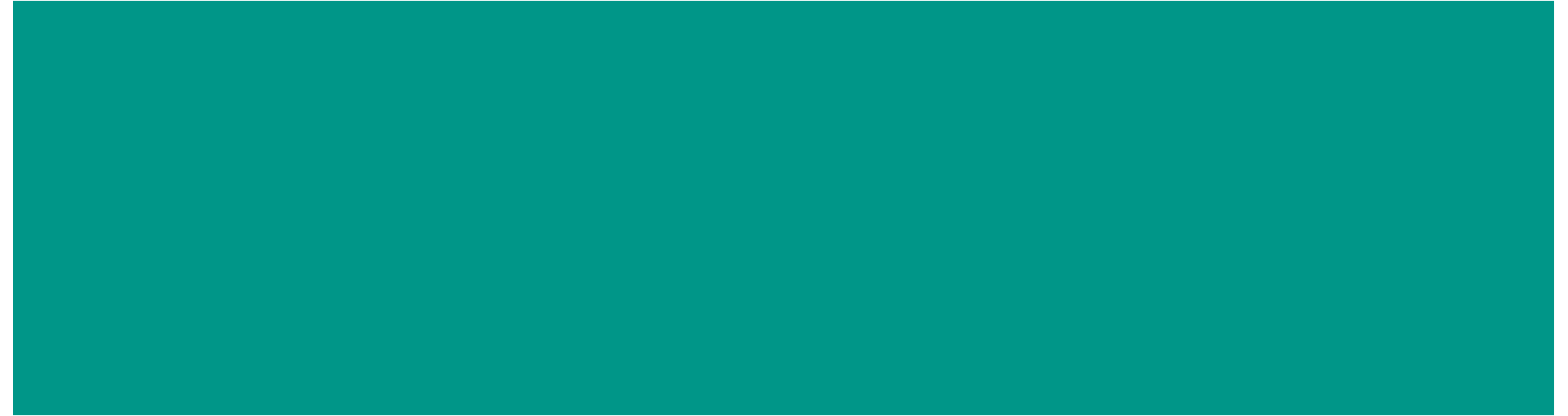

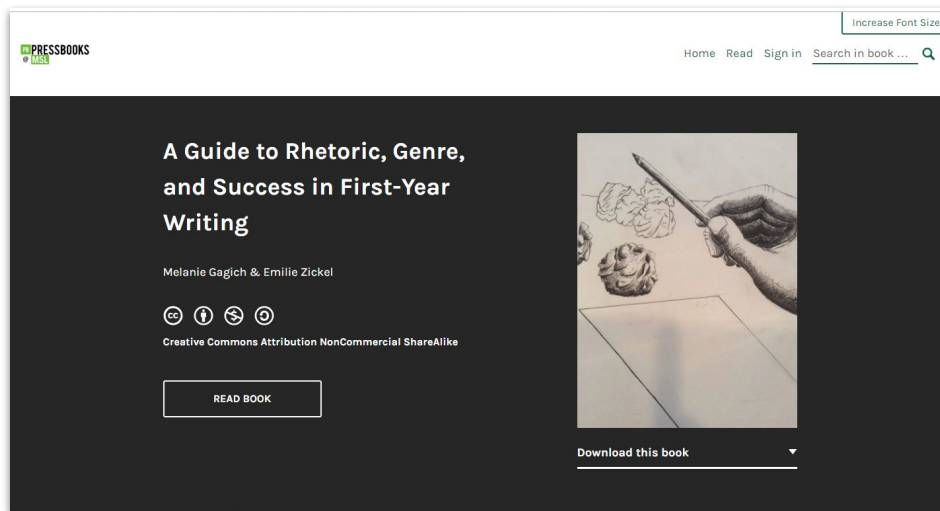
The Role of the Librarian
