Bay Home Looted

Police Chief John P. Eaton of Bay Village reported the burglary of a home about a mile west of the Samuel H. Sheppard home vesterday.

He said the residence of Larry Carman, 31013 West Lake, had been broken into between 7 a. m. and 4 p. m.

Taken were two revolvers, a shotgun, a \$500 diamond ring and a wrist watch. Entry was through a second-story dormer window. Fingerprints were being

taken to determine if there was any connection with the Sheppard murder. The burglars kicked a door from its frame to leave the

house after they had difficulty

in opening it. Eaton reported. Police saw in this "viciousness" a similarity to the maniacal attack on Mrs. Marilyn R. Sheppard.
