ENTERPRISE: More mechanical devices are being used in covering the Sheppard murder trial—to bring news and pictures to public attention fast—than in any other murder trial in the county's history.

At the Press, for instance, a special teletype is at City Editor Louis Clifford's elbow, bringing minute-by minute reports of the trial from the press room of the Criminal Courts Bldg. Yesterday a helicopter's services were engaged to take pictures from the air of the murder scene. Also, a motorcycle, run by Clark Hoffman, rushed pictures downtown from Bay Village as the jury visited the Sheppard home.
