## Sheppard Brothers **Defend Hospital** Dr. Stephen A. and Dr. Richard N. Sheppard declared today that

the publicity given to Bay View Hospital as the result of the murder of their sister-in-law has been

"harmful and unjust."

"Someone should show the type of service given to this community by this osteopathic hospital in the

face of neighborhood opposition," Dr. Richard said. Both doctors recalled the strug-
