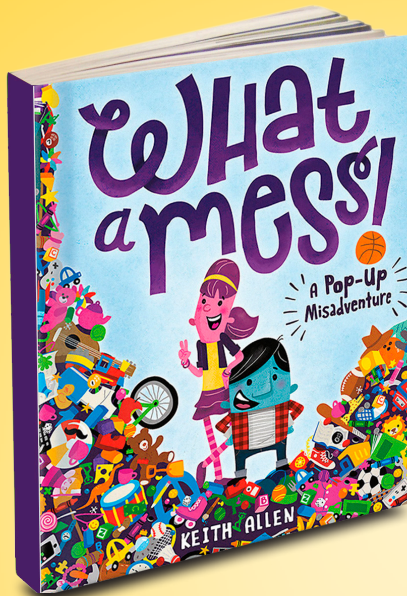


Making a Mess with Paper
