This special issue of Overseas Chinese Environmental Engineers and Scientists Association (OCEESA) Journal is dedicated to the loving memory of Professor Ju-Chang Howard Huang, Professor of Civil Engineering, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, Hong Kong, China. Professor Huang passed away on January 16, 2018, in Hong Kong, China.

Professor Huang was one of the founding members of OCEESA (Overseas Chinese Environmental Engineers and Scientists Association) 海外華人環保學會. Professor Huang and I were with OCEESA since the beginning of OCEESA in May 1980. Professor Huang and I were participants in the inaugurating meeting of OCEESA in Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana, May 1980. He was elected to Vice President of OCEESA in May 1980. In 1981 he was elected to President of OCEESA. Professor Huang and I were the only few OCEESA members who were with OCEESA for the entire history of OCEESA, from May 1980 to January 2018. Our OCEESA are very grateful to Professor Huang for his excellent leadership and guidance to OCEESA for the past 39 years. Professor Huang will be deeply missed by his family, his relatives, his friends, his colleagues and our OCEESA members.

Obituary of Professor Ju-Chang Howard Huang 黃汝常教授



Ju-Chang (Howard) Huang died on January 16, 2018 in Hong Kong after a brief illness. He was 77 years old.

Howard was born in Kaohsiung, Taiwan, on January 3, 1941, the third child of seven siblings. By the time of his high school graduation he was one of a hundred students in Taiwan to gain automatic admittance to the prestigious National Taiwan University without the prerequisite of entrance exams. He went on to complete his masters degree and PhD in less than three years time at the University of Texas-Austin, then began his professional career at the University of Missouri at Rolla (now Missouri University of Science and Technology), where he served as professor until 1992. In 1993 he was invited to begin an Environmental Engineering program at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, where he was a professor and researcher until the official end of his career in 2006. However, he remained passionate about the field of Environmental Engineering, and continued to do research and consultancies until the end of his life. Howard was also one of the founders of OCEESA (Overseas Chinese Environmental Engineers and Scientists Association).

Howard married Amy Hung Huang in 1965 and had two daughters, Alina and Nancy. The family was baptized at the First Assembly of God in Rolla before Amy died in 1983 after a prolonged battle with cancer. After Amy's death, Howard married Jolynn C. Huang in 1985 and had a third daughter, Jacqueline.

Howard enjoyed numerous travels both professionally, and for leisure, visiting nearly forty countries throughout his lifetime. Although he remained active in his professional work, he also devoted considerable time to his family. He was blessed with robust good health to nearly the end of his life, and loved climbing, bicycling, and hiking.

Howard is survived by his loving wife, daughters, and grandsons, Alex and Aidan Riley.

A memorial for Howard will be held at the Rolla Bible Church, 1801 E. 10th Street, Rolla, MO 65401, on Saturday, June 23, 2018, at 10:30 AM, with visitation beginning at 10:00 AM. The service will be followed by interment at Ozark Hills Memorial Gardens at 12110 US Hwy 63, Rolla, MO 65401.

Biography of Professor Ju-Chang Howard Huang 黃汝常教授

Ju-Chang "Howard" Huang was born in Kaohsiung, Taiwan on January 3, 1941. The third of seven siblings, he described himself scholastically as a "late bloomer"; however, by the time he graduated from high school, he was one of a hundred students automatically admitted to the National Taiwan University in Taipei. He earned his PhD in less than three years at University of Texas-Austin on scholarship, then became a professor at the University of Missouri at Rolla. He finished his career as professor at Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. He won numerous awards, and with more than 50 publications and nearly 1000 citations, he made a substantial and lasting contribution to the field of environmental engineering. After his official retirement in 2006, he continued to do consulting work internationally, and remained professionally active.

Howard married Amy Hung Huang in 1965 and had two children, Alina and Nancy. In 1983, Amy died after a long illness, and he was married to Jolynn C. Huang in 1985, after which he had a third daughter, Jacqueline. He remained physically vigorous his entire life, hiking, bicycling, and touring new areas until just eight weeks before his death.

Howard became a Christian in 1983 during his first wife's illness, and during the late stages of his own illness, experienced a true reawakening in the Lord. He had a glimpse of heaven, and revealed to his nurse that he knew that he was going back to God. His last request was that Jacqueline be baptised.

Howard is survived by his wife, daughters, and two grandsons, Alex Riley and Aidan Riley.

黃汝常教授生平

黃汝常於 1941 年 1 月 3 日出生於台灣高雄市，在七兄妹中排行老三；從小努力好學，是少數由高雄中學保送台大的資優生。赴美留學在不到三年時間即取得德州大學 (University of Texas-Austin) 碩士和博士學位。畢業後任教密蘇里裡大學 (University of Missouri-Rolla) 土木工程系二十餘年，1993 年香港科技大學延攬他開創土木工程系環境工程研究教學工作。

黃教授是享譽國際與國內的知名學者與工業廢水處理專家，除在各大國際刊物上發表近百篇論文創作，他在廢水處理上之成就堪稱卓越；曾為世界各地解決了許多棘手的廢水處理難題。

黃汝常於 1965 年與洪慧美結婚，育有大女兒黃逸倩（急診科醫生）及二女兒黃逸珊（內科小兒科醫生），1983 年慧美因病逝世後，黃教授於 1985 年與陳中苓共結連理，兩年後又添小女兒，黃逸怡。（任人事部經理）

黃汝常生性開朗，樂觀進取。教書，科研之外喜好旅遊，喜與家人好友相聚。1983年因著前妻的疾病，全家人一起受浸歸入神的大家庭。在這段生病的期間，上帝甦醒了他的靈魂：他曾多次告訴我們和加護病房的護士，他到了天堂，那兒是多麼的舒適；他已預備好自己要回那永遠的家了。他最後的交代是要小女兒受洗，翌日這個美好的心願在他病床前也完成了。

上帝是我們生命的導演，雖然有時我們沒有完全照著祂的旨意活出那豐盛的生命，但祂是信實慈愛的天父，祂愛黃汝常！祂為汝常寫了一個最完美的結局。

Memories of my Daddy, Professor Ju-Chang Howard Huang 黃汝常教授, by his Friends

Since Daddy's passing, we have been so touched to receive such an outpouring of messages and memories of Daddy that friends and colleagues have shared with us in the past few weeks. Some of these people weren't able to be here in-person today, but I wanted to share some of their messages and stories with you.

The first set of messages come from Daddy's college friends from National Taiwan University:

We are Howard's classmates from National Taiwan University's 1963 Civil Engineering graduating class. While we are unable to attend the memorial service for our dear classmate and friend in person, our hearts are here in spirit to say good-bye and celebrate his life.

We are at a loss for words in expressing our shock when we heard we had lost Howard on January 16th. Just three weeks earlier, on December 22nd, Howard sent an email to all of us reiterating his contact information in Hong Kong and Shenzhen. He did not say anything in his email about not feeling well and might have been thinking that his discomfort would go away in time. Life is more vulnerable than one would like to believe.

Soon, messages remembering Howard began to pour in. Except for 3 of us who attended the same high school as Howard, the rest of us met him for the first time in 1959. After graduation in 1963, we all went our separate ways but we met again during several reunion gatherings. We were fortunate enough to see Howard and Jolynn during our 2007, 2012, and 2014 reunions. In addition, they often looked up classmates when they came to the United States. I will now read some specific messages from Daddy's various classmates:

1. “黃汝常 was the first one among our classmates to get his Ph.D in 3 years. While the rest was still struggling working for a MS or Ph.D, he was already off pursuing his teaching and research career. In addition, it took Howard only 7 years to become a full professor. He was always ahead of us and no one actually caught him. 黃汝常 was smart and quite an achiever alright“
2. “黃汝常 was quite talkative and always upbeat and positive. When he is around, the atmosphere was always lively and no awkward silence.”
3. It was 2007 when we met Jolynn for the first time at our Panama Canal Cruise Class Reunion. It was delightful to see that our friendship as classmates instantly extended to our spouses as well. It was as if all of us had been friends for decades. Both Jolynn and Howard impressed us with their cheerful and charming personalities. As we all know,

whenever Howard was around, there were always good laughs and upbeat conversations. No matter what the subject matter was, he seemed to be able to offer constructive comments and useful suggestions. We met Howard and Jolynn again during a 2012 Caribbean cruise reunion and a 2014 Taiwan reunion. They were such an adorable couple! They were blessed to have each other.”

We are proud to have had such a special person and good friend as Howard in our lives. His sudden departure saddens us all. We will cherish him in our hearts and forever miss him.

The following is a message from Daddy’s friends from OCEESA, which is the Overseas Chinese Environmental Engineers and Scientists Association:

We are very grateful for Prof. Ju-Chang Howard Huang, 黃汝常教授 excellent leadership and outstanding service to our OCEESA for over the past 38 years and to MTEPC for over the past 26 years. Prof. Huang will be deeply missed by his friends inside and outside of OCEESA.

We are very saddened by the passing away of our beloved friend, but he will always be remembered and highly respected by all of us! May God grant perfect peace to Prof. Huang's family.

The last message is from one of Daddy’s PhD students who lives overseas and could not be here today:

I was Prof. Huang’s first PhD student at HKUST. Prof. Huang was always like my father and a great teacher/mentor. I am here because of him. He was a tough teacher, but that toughness helped us to find our destiny. He will be missed by many of us.

Of course this is just a small sampling of messages that have come in, but we are so appreciative of the love and support that everyone has provided during this transitional time.

I have known Professor Ju-Chang Howard Huang 黃汝常教授 for over 48 years since 1970 to the time of his passing away in 2018. Both Howard and I both have our PhD from University of Texas at Austin (UT Austin), Texas, USA. He is 3 years ahead of me. We have different PhD dissertation advisors. In 1970, Howard was attending conference in Houston, Texas, and came to visit us in our apartment in Houston. We have known Howard since that time. Professor Huang is one of the most outstanding PhD students in environmental engineering at UT Austin, he did so well and obtained his MS and PhD degrees from UT Austin in 3 years period of time. Most students will take from 5 to 6 years to get both MS and PhD degrees at UT Austin. He started graduate study at UT Austin 1964 and has obtained his PhD in 1967 under Dr. Ernest Gloyna. My PhD is in 1970 under Prof. Wesley W. Eckenfelder.

In 1974, on our way to my teaching job at University of North Dakota, USA, we stopped in Howard's home in Rolla, Missouri. We were very happy to meet Mrs. Amy Hung Huang (Mrs. Ju-Chang Howard Huang) 洪慧美, and their 2 daughters. Our 2 daughters and Prof. Hung's 2 older daughters have good time playing together during our visit in that day. Little did I know at that time that 3 of these 4 girls will be medical doctors when they grew up. Our younger daughter, Virginia Singlan Hung 洪心蘭, MD, is hand surgeon in private practice in Boston. I understand Howard's 2 older daughters, Alina H. Waring (Huang) 黃逸倩, MD, Nancy H. Riley (Huang) 黃逸珊, MD, are emergency medicine physician, Chillicothe, Missouri, and internal medicine and pediatrician, Cincinnati, Ohio, respectively. Howard gave us a guided tour of his large beautiful house during our visit. He designed the house himself. Howard is not only an outstanding environmental engineering professor, he is also an excellent Civil Engineer. Howard is so outstanding that excelled himself so well at University of Missouri at Rolla. He was promoted from assistant professor to tenured associate professor in 3 years and was promoted from associate professor to full professor in 5 years. I understand Howard was one of the youngest full professor at University of Missouri at Rolla at that time. Howard is one of the most outstanding graduates from UT Austin.

I am extremely thankful to Howard for inviting me to teach for 1 semester at his department at HKUST (Hong Kong University of Science and Technology) in Fall 1996 during my sabbatical leave from Cleveland State University, USA. It was the most happy period of my life. Up to the present time I have taught for 48 years in my university teaching career. I enjoyed teaching at

HKUST very much. I have been invited to Prof. Hung's and Mrs. Jolynn Huang's home several time and was invited to Chinese restaurants for dim Sim many times by Howard. My wife, Mrs. Louisa Ming-Hwa Hung 湯明華, joined me in Hong Kong during the last 2 weeks of Fall semester in 1996. Ming-Hwa and I are very thankful to Howard and Mrs. Jolynn Chen Huang (Mrs. Howard Ju-Chang Huang) 陳中苓, and their daughter, Jacqueline Huang 黃逸怡, for their hospitality and friendship extended to us during our stay in Hong Kong in Fall semester 1996.

Prof. Huang is one of the founding members of OCEESA (Overseas Chinese Environmental Engineers and Scientists Association) 海外華人環保學會. He and I were with OCEESA since the beginning of OCEESA in May 1980. Howard and I were participants in the inaugurating meeting of OCEESA in Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana. He was elected to Vice President of OCEESA in May 1980. In 1981 he was elected to President of OCEESA. Professor Huang and I were the only few OCEESA members who were with OCEESA since the beginning of OCEESA, in May 1980, until he passed away in January 2018. Our OCEESA are very grateful to Professor Huang for his excellent leadership and guidance to OCEESA for the 38 years period from 1980 to 2018. Based on my observation for the past 40 years, Howard is the best President of OCEESA during the 40 years of history of OCEESA. Our OCEESA is very grateful for Professor Ju-Chang Howard Huang's outstanding service, leadership, and contributions to our OCEESA.

I am so grateful that I have the honor to be Howard friend for over 48 years. I will miss deeply Howard's friendship in the years to come. Although Howard is no longer with us, his memory will stay with me for the rest of my life.

黃汝常於 1941 年 1 月 3 日出生於台灣高雄市，在七兄妹中排行老三；從小努力好學，是少數由高雄中學保送台大的資優生。赴美留學在不到三年時間即取得德州大學(University of Texas-Austin)碩士和博士學位。畢業後任教密蘇里裡大學(University of Missouri-Rolla)土木工程系二十餘年，1993 年香港科技大學延攬他開創土木工程系環境工程研究教學工作。

黃教授是享譽國際與國內的知名學者與工業廢水處理專家，除在各大國際刊物上發表近百篇論文創作，他在廢水處理上之成就堪稱卓越；曾為世界各地解決了許多棘手的廢水處理難題。

黃汝常於 1965 年與洪慧美結婚，育有大女兒逸倩（急診科醫生）及二女兒逸珊（內科小兒科醫生），1983 年慧美因病逝世後，黃教授於 1985 年與陳中苓共結連理，兩年後又添小女兒逸怡。（任人事部經理）

黃汝常生性開朗，樂觀進取。教書，科研之外喜好旅遊，喜與家人好友相聚。1983 年因著前妻的疾病，全家人一起受浸歸入神的大家庭。在這段生病的期間，上帝甦醒了他的靈魂：他曾多次告訴我們和加護病房的護士，他到了天堂，那兒是多麼的舒適；他已預備好自己要回那永遠的家了。他最後的交代是要小女兒受洗，翌日這個美好的心願在他病床前也完成了。

上帝是我們生命的導演，雖然有時我們沒有完全照著祂的旨意活出那豐盛的生命，但祂是信實慈愛的天父，祂愛黃汝常！祂為汝常寫了一個最完美的結局。

Biography

Ju-Chang "Howard" Huang was born in Kaohsiung, Taiwan on January 3, 1941. The third of seven siblings, he described himself scholastically as a "late bloomer"; however, by the time he graduated from high school, he was one of a hundred students automatically admitted to the National Taiwan University in Taipei. He earned his PhD in less than three years at University of Texas-Austin on scholarship, then became a professor at the University of Missouri at Rolla. He finished his career as professor at Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. He won numerous awards, and with more than 50 publications and nearly 1000 citations, he made a substantial and lasting contribution to the field of environmental engineering. After his official retirement in 2006, he continued to do consulting work internationally, and remained professionally active.

Howard married Amy Hung Huang in 1965 and had two children, Alina and Nancy. In 1983, Amy died after a long illness, and he was married to Jolynn C. Huang in 1985, after which he had a third daughter, Jacqueline. He remained physically vigorous his entire life, hiking, bicycling, and touring new areas until just eight weeks before his death.

Howard became a Christian in 1983 during his first wife's illness, and during the late stages of his own illness, experienced a true reawakening in the Lord. He had a glimpse of heaven, and revealed to his nurse that he knew that he was going back to God. His last request was that Jacqueline be baptised.
