Sheppard Home Return Is Sought

The Bay Village home in which Marilyn R. Sheppard was brutally beaten to death on July 4 may soon be the object of a court fight over its possession, prosecutors and defense attorneys indicated today.

In declining a request by Dr. Samuel H. Sheppard, the victim's husband held in County Jail on a first degree indictment, that possession of the home be returned to his family, County Prosecutor Frank T. Cullitan said it would be released only under a court order.

Fred W. Garmone, co-defense counsel for the 30-year-old osteopathic surgeon, said he and other attorneys have not decided whether to seek a court order for possession of the home at 28924 W. Lake Rd., Bay Village.
