Dr. Sam Now in Pen Print Shop

Dr. Samuel H. Sheppard's name brought unusual attention yesterday to the death of an Ohio Penitentiary inmate from drinking wood alcohol.

During the investigation, all prison nurses on duty—including Dr. Sam, convicted wife slayer—were relieved of their duties. An osteopath, Dr. Sheppard has served in the penitentiary hospital in Columbus.

All were exonerated of any connection with the death, but were "routinely" transferred to other duties, Warden Ralph W. Alvis said. He emphasized that 150 men a day are transferred to new jobs. Dr. Sam will go to the prison's print shop.

William Miller, editor of the Ohio Penitentiary News, died Thursday after drinking wood alcohol obtained from the prison gymnasium. The alcohol was intended for use in rubdowns.
