You have been called as prospective members of this panel, and since you have been you will bear in mind in detail these instructions which I am now about to give you, and you will bear these instructions in mind in detail on each occasion that you leave this room, whether you leave together or individually.

You shall not discuss this case amongst yourselves, or what little you know of it.

You shall not permit yourselves to overhear anything that relates to this case by any means or media of communication.

You shall not permit anyone else to discuss this case with you.

Bear these instructions in mind on each occasion. More specifically, if you should pick up a newspaper, and the newspaper or any other written material treats of this matter which we are concerned with this morning, you shall forbear and you shall not read that part of the newspaper, or any part of it which relates to this case, or written publication.

If you are listening to the radio you shall either walk away from the radio or turn it off if reference is made by anyone to this case.

If you are looking at a television set, the same rule applies. You shall either turn it off, or walk away from it.

You shall not permit yourselves under any circumstances to overhear anything that relates to this case by any means or media of communication.

Do each of you understand those instructions?
