

DOROTHY SHEPPARD, having been previously sworn,  
was recalled and further testified as follows:

FURTHER EXAMINATION OF DOROTHY SHEPPARD

BY DR. GERBER:

Q You are Mrs. Dorothy Sheppard?

A Yes, sir.

Q You testified previously?

A Yes, sir.

Q When you testified on a previous occasion I asked  
you whether or not you had written a letter to Marilyn  
Sheppard in regard to marital difficulties that they were  
having in which you gave advice?

A Yes, sir.

Q Do you recall now what you wrote?

A No, sir, I do not recall.

Q Is this your handwriting and signature?

A Yes, sir.

Q Would you read that letter to yourself to help you  
refresh your mind?

A (Witness reads letter.)

DR. GERBER: Let the record  
show that Mr. William J. Corrigan repeatedly  
interrupted the process of this trial, and  
had been informed on numerous occasions to

not interfere, at this particular time he continued to interfere and would not cease after being warned. He <sup>was</sup> warned that he would be asked to leave or ejected if he wouldn't leave. He was asked to sit down first. He refused to sit down and I therefore ordered him removed or ejected from the hearing room.

Q Now, Mrs. Sheppard, after having refreshed your memory, will you now state for the record the advice that you gave to Marilyn Sheppard and why you gave that advice?

A Dr. Gerber, the advice that I wrote my sister-in-law in that letter is I think typically summed up in one of the sentences there, the preaching of a big sister.

I think very often big sisters do as mothers do, have a tendency to preach, and we may make things appear much greater than they really are.

Q What year was this written in?

A The date wasn't on the letter, I don't believe, was it? It says August 28.

Q Is this your handwriting on the envelope?

A Yes, sir.

Q And that says August 28, 1950, does it?

A 1950.

DR. GERBER: That is all.

Thank you.

This inquiry is now recessed for further hearing, and at which time the hearings will be held at my office, 2121 Adelbert Road, Cleveland, Ohio.
