THE COURT: Well, frankly, gentlemen, at this time I find no reason in my judgment why Mrs. Grodzinski should be excused as a juror at this time, predicated upon what she has told me.

MR. CORRIGAN: The State has no quarrel with that, Judge.

THE COURT: Let the record show, and the record does show, that this conference is being held in Chambers, outside the hearing of anyone except Counselors. Let the record show that the Court believes that Mrs. Grodzinski can physically or has the physical capacity to sit as a juror, in this cause, and the Court is going to permit her to sit and swear her as a member of this petit jury this afternoon.

(Thereupon proceedings were resumed in the courtroom, in the presence and hearing of the jury panel, as follows:)

THE COURT: Ladies and gentlemen of the panel, will each of you stand and raise your right arm.

(Thereupon the jury was duly sworn by the Court.)
