

THE COURT: Be seated, please.

Now, may I see Counselors at the side of the bench?
(Thereupon Counsel and the Court conferred at the Court's bench out of the hearing of the jury.)

THE COURT: Mr. Patrick and Mr. Reed, would you bring back those who have not been sworn?

(Balance of prospective jurors come into courtroom.)

THE COURT: Ladies and gentlemen in the back of the room, if you wish to leave you may, while the panel is being brought in.

Mr. Ainsley and Mrs. Koch, as you see, we have sworn a jury of twelve petit jurors in connection with this case. But we are going to put in alternate jurors on Monday.

In the event, although we certainly do not anticipate it, or hope that it occurs, but in the event that one of our jurors should become ill or by some fortuitous or uncontrollable event in their lives, be unable to complete their jury service, we will have alternate jurors impaneled, and we are going to impanel these alternate jurors on Monday.

So you are now requested to return on Monday, and you will be considered as prospective

alternate jurors in this case.

The instructions I now give to you, ladies and gentlemen, are instructions for each of the fourteen of you, and these are that you shall not discuss this case or what little you have heard of it, even amongst yourselves; you shall not permit anyone else to discuss this case with you. You shall not permit yourselves to overhear anything that relates to this case by any means or media of communication, and you shall bear in mind in detail the instructions given you with respect to not listening to radio commentators, television commentators, viewing any pictures on television that may relate to this case, reading any material in newspapers, periodicals, magazines, books, or otherwise.

If you should come across an allusion to this case in any printed material, you are forbidden to read it.

Do each of you understand, or is there any question in your minds about these instructions? If there are, please raise your right arm.

We will stand adjourned, then, until 9:15 Monday morning.
