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Monday Morning Session, 9:15 a.m., October 31, 1966

(Thereupon the following proceedings were had in the Court's Chambers:)

THE COURT: Gentlemen, let the record show that earlier this morning, that the Court received the following note signed by Thomas Tenerovich, a member of this jury which was sworn on Friday afternoon. The note reads as follows:

"Due to my health, I would like to be excused from the jury."

Signed, Thomas Tenerovich.

Gentlemen, it is my understanding after conference with you, prior to calling the court reporter into Chambers, that it is agreeable that we impanel or attempt to impanel three alternate jurors in this case, with the understanding that the first alternate impaneled will become a member of the jury, of the twelve which will deliberate this case, in the event the alternate's services are not required, and that after we have impaneled, or, after we have sworn three alternates, that the Court then advise Mr. Tenerovich that his request to be excused as a member

of this petit panel is granted.

Mr. Corrigan, do you wish to speak to the record in this connection?

MR. CORRIGAN: I concur in the remarks and observations made by the Court, and I have no objection to that procedure.

THE COURT: Mr. Bailey, do you wish to speak to the record?

MR. BAILEY: Yes. The defendant desires to have Mr. Tenerovich excused, in view of his health, and we feel that the procedure suggested by the Court is the proper one under these circumstances, and I have no objection to it.

THE COURT: Thank you, gentlemen.
(Thereupon proceedings were resumed in the courtroom in the presence and the hearing of the jury panel, as follows:)

THE COURT: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Ladies and gentlemen of the panel, before commencing the impaneling of the prospective alternates in this case, the Court again admonishes you that you shall not discuss even amongst yourselves what little you know of this case.

You shall not permit anyone else to discuss
