Dear Mr. Bailey:

With reference to your letter dated November 23, 1966, I wish to advise you that this information was turned over to the Grand Jury of Cuyahoga County.

On December 15, 1966, the Grand Jury submitted their report to Judge Roy F. McMahon, Presiding Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Cuyahoga County in Cleveland, Ohio, stating that on information provided by you and others, they found no testimony or evidence to warrant the indictment of the persons named in your letter.

The Bay Village Police Department has no intention of making any further investigation and, in view of the Grand Jury report, considers the case closed.
