I understand that I am not compelled to make this statement and that I have no control over how it may be used and that no promises are made to me because of it.

I made arrangements with Dr. Haversten for a golf game Sunday morning (July 4, 1954) - and for supper the evening before. Dr. Haversten arrived in Kent about 7:30 PM Saturday, stayed for supper and then we talked until about 9:00 midnight when we started to retire. We listened to the baseball game until the finish, then retired immediately.

Sunday morning we went golfing about 9:30 AM, and completed our game just before 2:00 PM. Dr. Haversten learned of Marilyn's death shortly afterward (about 2:30 PM) and left for Cleveland within 1 hour.
