


Cleveland State University 4th Annual Regional Chemistry Symposium March 12 and 13, 2015

The 4th Annual Regional Chemistry Symposium will be held at Cleveland State University, Student Center Building, 2121 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44115 (corner of Euclid and East 22nd Street).

From Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE) Distance: 12 miles. From airport, take highway 71 North (which turns into 90 East) to the East 9th Street exit #172A. Take East 9th St. to Euclid Ave. and turn right. The Wyndham will be two blocks down on the right.
